He said the arctangent (.865) of the "D&M Pyramid" geodetic Martian latitude (40.87 N) is the same (within one part in a 1000) as the cosine of the Sphinx's latitude on Earth. Richard C. Hoagland, he said, made a presentation to the U.N. in 1992 based upon this geometrical relationship.

He also pointed me to the Watcher Website, which is located at www.mt.net. This site presents Biblical prophecies related to the constellations, and there are mathematical and topographical presentations linking Egypt to Mars there as well. One last site he told me to study was www.planetarymysteries.com, which states that it is dedicated to the research of new paradigms in science and art, as well as breakthroughs that are bringing about new understandings of our past, present and future.

So what I thought, anyone could put up a Website, just like anyone can write a book. It doesn't mean that it is the truth.
